**RE: Year 6 Form Group and House**

I am writing to inform you of the House and Form Group that your child has been allocated prior to their start in Year 7. The House colours match the tie that they will need (**Bronte – purple tie; Holtby – blue tie; Johnson – red tie; and Mortimer – green tie**).

We will be writing to all parents in August with detailed guidance about what next year will look like. However, we will go through this in detail with Year 7 on the first day. Please note, that Year 7 will be the only full year group in school on the first day to allow us to cover all the areas we would have normally done on our induction day. Their first day back is **Tuesday 8 September** and there will be plenty of staff to direct them at each of the entrances to site. Please ensure they arrive by **8.40 am**.


